

Tennessee Patriot Grave Marking Service



Kentucky Society President Geoff Baggett and Col. Stephen Trigg Chapter President Steve Mallory joined the men of the Tennessee Society in a special grave marking ceremony near Knoxville on Friday, March 23. The ceremony was held in conjunction with the spring meeting of the Tennessee Society. President General Larry Guzy was present, making this a National Color Guard Event.

The ceremony was conducted at the Eusebia Presbyterian Church near Seymour, Tennessee. The church dates back to the founding of a frontier fort in the valley in 1784. At least fifteen Revolutionary War Patriots are interred in the historic cemetery.

President Baggett played drum for the Color Guard and presented a wreath on behalf of the Kentucky Society. Compatriot Mallory proudly carried the Kentucky flag in the Color Guard procession and fired his personally-crafted long rifle in the flintlock salute.


